

PERMISSION FOR PHOTOGRAPHY

MODEL RELEASE - MINOR

For good and valuable consideration, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, I hereby grant to <u>PRO Motorcycle Training, LLC (PROMCT)</u> and the <u>Motorcycle Safety Foundation (MSF)</u> the absolute and irrevocable right and permission, with respect to any photographs or video that it or its agent will take of my child (who is under 18 years of age), to copyright the same, in PROMCT's and/or MSF's name, to use and publish the same in whole or in part, in any media now or hereafter, and for promotional or any other purpose whatsoever, and to use my child's name in connection therewith if PROMCT and/or MSF so chooses.
